

MILL BAY WATERWORKS DISTRICT Drought Conditions Toll Surcharge

BYLAW NO. 269

A bylaw to further encourage water conservation during drought conditions.

WHEREAS the Mill Bay Waterworks District has authority under Section 698 of the *Local Government Act* to establish tolls and other charges payable to the District and the times of their payment, to establish discounts or percentage additions to encourage the prompt payment of the tolls and other charges, and to establish penalties for failure to comply with the regulations.

AND WHEREAS the Mill Bay Waterworks applies water conservation restrictions on the use of water for other than normal domestic household use, in progressively more restrictive stages (Stages 1, 2, and 3) during the period May 1 to October 31 each year depending on the prevailing drought conditions.

AND WHEREAS the Mill Bay Waterworks wishes to further encourage compliance with the Stage 3 water conservation restrictions.

The Trustees of Mill Bay Waterworks District (the “**District**”) ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1. In the event that Stage 3 Water Conservation Restrictions are in force at the start of the August/October billing cycle, the Tier 4 and where applicable Tier 5 user tolls set out in Schedule A of Current Water Tolls and Other Charges Bylaw will be increased by 25% for the duration of the August/October billing cycle. These increased rates will be used in calculating the water toll charges for Tier 4 and 5 water consumption in the August/October billing cycle.

Application

2. This Bylaw applies to all properties which receive water from the Mill Bay Waterworks District (the “**District**”).

3. This Bylaw may be cited for all purposes as “**Bylaw No. 269 Drought Conditions Toll Surcharge.**”
